Drug driving testing-Update



I trust you are keeping well.

As you know there has been many years research involved in identifying the most suitable technology with which to test drivers for drugs.

Amongst the many challenges that the government has set is to identify a suitable device that can detect cannabis at reasonable levels.

Many trials have been undertaken under the auspices of the Home Office and the most recent as you know has set the 'type approval' standards for drug testing equipment and set cut off levels for cannabis and other drugs.

Trials are currently underway to identify the most appropriate equipment that can not only meet those standards but would be suitable for use by the UK Police. Because of the demanding nature of those trials a number of major drug testing companies have already dropped out because they are unable to meet the high standard set. Many of our clients are already placing orders for the 'drugalyser'® in anticipation of the introduction of drug driving testing standards in the new year.
